Holy Thursday

- 7:30 pm Mass of the Lord's Supper
9:00 pm Adoration in Flynn Hall until 11:50 pm.

Please note that there are no other Masses on Holy Thursday

Good Friday

Remember: Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence (no meat or products made from meat; 1 full meal and 2 small snacks only with no snacking in between meals)

- 12:10 pm Stations of the Cross
7:30 pm Good Friday Commemoration of the Lord's Passion

Please note that there are no Masses on Good Friday. Holy Communion will be distributed only at the Good Friday Service in the evening.

While Holy Thursday and Good Friday are not days of obligation, they are important celebrations; it is hoped that all devout Catholics will try to attend both, and that most of our Sunday Mass-goers will try to make it to at least one of the services.

Holy Saturday

- 8:30 pm Easter Vigil Mass

Please note that there are no Masses before nightfall on this day.

The Easter Vigil Mass is the most important Mass of the liturgical year, and contains many beautiful rituals and actions which are not found in any other Masses. We encourage everyone to consider setting aside their normal Saturday evening activities to come and experience this wonderful liturgy. It normally lasts a bit over two hours at Saint Mary's.
