

# About the Haymarket Park Rosary Crusade Event

**WHERE:** Haymarket Park in Lincoln, NE

**WHEN:** Sunday May 5, 2019 at 7 pm (Gates open at 5:00)

**ADMISSION IS FREE!** Distribution of Miraculous Medals, rosaries and bottled water are also free. Gates will open at 5:00 pm and seats are first come first serve!

**CONFESSION** will be offered from 5:30 to 6:45 pm, with 6 priests on hand to administer the sacrament.

A **CHOIR** made up of members from parishes around the Diocese of Lincoln will sing beautiful Eucharistic and Marian hymns in Latin and English during the Eucharistic Procession, Adoration and Global Living Rosary.

**FOOD & DRINK** is not able to be brought into the stadium, but free water will be provided to all attendees.

**TAILGATING** (non-alcoholic) is welcome in the parking lot prior to the Crusade.

## What to expect during the Evening of Eucharistic Adoration and Global Living Rosary

One of the Blessed Mother's last messages at Fatima was to say the final battle will be over marriage and the family. She asked us to pray the Rosary daily to obtain peace and victory. With Bishop James Conley and Crusade founder Fr. James Kelleher, we come together to honor Our Lady of Fatima on this 102-year Anniversary of the Fatima Apparitions, and to pray for peace in our families, our nation and throughout the world.

The evening will begin at 7 pm with an entrance procession of Our Lady of Fatima led by Bishop Conley, including a large number of this year's First Communicants in their white garments. A six-year old girl will crown Our Lady and Bishop Conley will consecrate the diocese to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

After the consecration to Our Lady, Bishop Conley will lead a Eucharistic procession of 300 people onto the field and place Jesus on an elevated altar over 2nd base. A large diocesan choir will sing beautiful hymns as thousands worship Jesus, the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords, the Prince of Peace!

We will build one of the largest rosaries in the world along the baseline, with each bead 3 feet in diameter. People representing countries from around the world will form the "living beads" of the Global Living Rosary, with each decade representing a different continent. Each "living bead" will pray the first part of the Hail Mary in a foreign language and the congregation will respond in English.

\* Upcoming activities include Handing out Carnations on Mother's Day provided by the Knights and Altar Society.

\* Recent activities include the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday Rosary March 31<sup>st</sup>, and helping with preparation for Holy Week Services in the Church.
