Devotion to Saint Joseph

during the year dedicated to him, 2021

This Devotion is stretched out over a greater period of time than the usual Novena so that more people can work around time constraints and still participate. It also connects the two important Feasts of Saint Joseph, on March 19th and May 1st. The components of the Devotion are:

Attend Mass on the Solemnity of Saint Joseph

We will have a special Mass at 7 pm that Friday evening, although you may attend any Mass at any parish throughout the city. We will be giving out the Devotional booklets that evening.

Follow the Devotion as set up with 9 sets of days, with four days each. During each of these sets of four days:

Recite the prayers and ponder the meditations found in the book "Nine Days With St. Joseph."

These will be done publically following the last Mass of the day on the first of the four days listed, but may also be done privately at any time during the four days.

Either pay a visit to the Blessed Sacrament for a time of silent prayer (15 minutes) or, if coming to the church is difficult, pray a rosary at home. The church is accessible with the keypad between 7 am and 8 pm at the east door facing K Street. The 15 minutes of adoration should be in addition to, not part of, any public liturgies or devotions.

In lieu of the Devotional prayers, concentrate on the Easter Triduum during those days. If possible, attend Holy Thursday Mass, the Commemoration of Our Lord's Passion on Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. Attend at least ONE of these as part of "bridging" the days of the devotion.

Attend Mass on Easter Sunday or, if you choose to attend the Easter Vigil Mass, having fulfilled the Sunday observance, attend Mass on Sunday, Monday, or Tuesday in lieu of the Devotional prayers. The Devotional prayers resume on Wednesday, April 7th.

Attend Mass at the conclusion of the Devotion, either at the special Votive Mass for Saint Joseph on Friday, April 30th, or on Saturday, May 1st, the Feast of Saint Joseph the Worker.

Note that the 4 pm Mass on Saturday, May 1st will NOT be the Mass for Saint Joseph the Worker, but will be the anticipated Mass for the 5th Sunday of Easter, and is therefore not part of the devotion.

The Holy Father has issued a decree granting a plenary indulgence to the faithful under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the Pope's intentions) to those who, with a spirit detachment from any sin, participate in the year of Saint Joseph on these occasions and manners:

- 1) Celebrate the Solemnity of Saint Joseph on March 19 with an act of piety in honor of Saint Joseph
- 2) Pray an approved prayer to St. Joseph on the 19th of any month
- 3) Honor Saint Joseph with an act of piety or approved prayer on a Wednesday, the day traditionally dedicated to him
- 4) Celebrate the feast of St. Joseph the Worker on May 1st with an act of piety or prayer.
