Facility Audit. The Clark & Enersen team was on site this past Tuesday, making a visual assessment of the church and collecting the information they will need to organize the study of the building. This included specialists in architectural, mechanical, and structural engineering. They walked the premises, took pictures, spoke to maintenance personnel and made requests for some of the documentation we have on past maintenance and repair work. I anticipate the audit report sometime in November. Great progress!

Bishop's Appeal for Vocations. We will formally begin the Bishop's Appeal for Vocations this weekend, with donation cards available in the vestibule of the church, this weekend and next. This appeal is a one-time gift, typically by check or cash. We do have the capacity for electronic giving, which is very easy.
