From The Pastor's Desk.....

Pro-Life Holy Hour and Rosary. St. Mary's offers a holy hour of Eucharistic Adoration on Monday nights, beginning at 6pm. At 6:30, we pray a rosary together for the children at risk of abortion on Tuesdays at Planned Parenthood. We also remember the moms and dads, the sidewalk counselors, other pro-life workers and the doctors and workers associated with the abortion industry. Benediction is given about 6:55 and we then celebrate Mass together at 7pm. It is a beautiful devotion arising in the parish. Join us during the month of October, if you can. It is Pro-Life month in the Church, as well as the month we dedicate to the Rosary.

Thank You Again! Contributions to the Bishop's Appeal for Vocations continue to come in. Presently, I am reporting \$18,775 in donations to the appeal. God bless you all for this generosity. Donations that are received each year, in excess of what the diocese needs, are invested in the Catholic Foundation of Southern Nebraska for seminary education and an even greater outcome is achieved: the perpetual support of vocations! Very nice.

Mission Statement Meeting with John Ferrone. Those interested in continuing the mission statement discussion are invited to a meeting on Tuesday, October 12 at 7pm in the classroom beneath the rectory, facilitated by John Ferrone. In other news regarding the visioning process, I sent John's contract to the chancery early this week and requested permission to engage his services. I anticipate hearing back from the chancery sometime next week.

Hosting the Deanery Priests. Last Tuesday, we hosted the Deanery priests at St. Mary's, beginning with a Eucharistic Holy Hour, followed with drinks and an outdoor barbecue in the courtyard, between the rectory and the church. We had eleven priests with us, and we ate and laughed and told stories (most of them true) together for a couple of hours. Our staff (Gloria, Barb and Teresa) did much of the set-up and food preparation. It was a very nice event and the priests were all impressed with the beautiful holy hour, the courtyard, and the hospitality they received.

Special Collections in the Parish. I have authorized the Knights of Columbus to take up a second collection in the parish on the weekend of October 16/17, part of their Tootsie Roll Drive, or more appropriately, The Campaign for People with Intellectual Disabilities.
