Notes from the Pastor...

**Attorney General's Report.** This past Thursday, the Attorney General's office issued the report on Clergy Sexual Abuse in the three Catholic diocese of our state. The study included cases going back to 1978. The Bishops of Nebraska cooperated fully with the Attorney General's office so that the report is an accurate representation of facts that are known regarding allegations of misconduct against Catholic clergy and how the Chanceries across our state managed these cases. Since 2002, as is noted in the report, measures have been taken so the criminal activity by church personnel includes the participation-early on- of law enforcement.

All of us are saddened, angered, bleeding from this story in our Catholic community. The victims are our friends, our family, our parishioners. The priests are our relatives, friends and fathers too. It happened in the parishes and institutions we treasure, against those we promised to protect. I could fill this page with descriptive words trying to express the depth, the gravity, the ugliness, the wound, the tears, the grief, the loss from this story. I feel for everyone involved in this.

My role, as your pastor, is to help you wade through these dark times and not allow them to harm your faith. The way I will do this is to live my priesthood to the best of my ability, to be faithful to Christ, to the Church I love, and to the people entrusted to my care. God allowed this harm to come to us. He is also present in every human suffering, in every sin, in every wound against His children, His priests, and His bride the Church. Be faithful, is His message in my heart. Yes, is my response.

Notes from the Restoration Chair, Ted Czerniak...

**Update on restoration committee meeting.** Repair of front steps, removal of plaster ceiling in kitchen, organ repair, air conditioning repairs and match donations for restorations. Front steps taking place now. Help needed on November 13 th to take down ceiling and plaster in kitchen. Parish members are asked to take part in this project to save over 5,000 dollars in repair costs. Work will start at 8:00 am. Members are asked to bring masks, goggles/eye protection, ladders, shop vacs, tarps and any other tools you might think will help.

Thanks for your help with matching donations of \$82,960 but we still need \$17,040.

We are having a parish meeting open to all members about the total restoration of the church on November 30th at 7:00 pm in the church basement. Clark & Enersen will go over what needs to be done and the cost of the total restoration of St. Mary's.
